Last Tango in Paris is without doubt the most controversial film of the last 50 years. A scandalous film, censored in the years of sexual liberation, it later became an emblem of the power of the male gaze in cinema following accusations by Maria Schneider. Behind the moral outrage, the trials and the scandals, the deep contradictions of our society and the power relations that rule it are revealed: the power of censorship and the state over freedom of expression, the power of the director over the actors and the power of patriarchy over women. We'll tell the story of Bertolucci's masterpiece to investigate the changes in our society to which no one can claim to be a stranger.
