

"Pietre" is a mini-series about three witnesses of justice, that is, three ordinary citizens who chose to report mafia crimes without ever committing any. They are, to this day, alive. The first episode, "Tufo", is the story of Ignazio Cutrò and how, together with his family, he managed to remain in Sicily with his face uncovered. The second episode, "Marmo", is the story of Giuseppe Carini and how the meeting with Father Pino Puglisi transformed him from a potential 'man of honor' to an immaculate servant of the State. The third episode, "Ardesia", is the story of Maria Stefanelli and how a woman from a mafia family, on her own, managed to get out of hell to save her daughter.

In 2024 she worked as storyboard-artist for the feature film "A journey to Teulada" and for the tv series "Anselmo Wannabe".
